Decorate your table with a really quick-and-easy to make candle mat. The beautiful colors of fall leaves make everyone feel good. Have your own scattering of leaves on a wool candle mat!

Make Freezer Paper Templates

- If needed, steam press your wool.
- Draw patterns on freezer paper (shiny side down) using Design Illustrations.
- Cut out near the drawn lines and iron (shiny side down) onto your wool.
- Cut out the patterns on the drawn lines with sharp appliqué scissors.

Appliqué Instructions

- Center the leaves in the mat scallops and attach with randomly placed Straight Stitches.
 - Use #902 burgundy on the rust leaf
 - Use 937 olive on the olive leaves.
 - Use 783 gold on the gold leaf.
 - Use 300 brown on the rust and caraway leaves.
- Finish the mat edge with gold Running Stitch with a French Knot at the top of each scallop.

Materials Needed

- 8" x 8" Yellow felted wool
- 2" x 4" each of Gold, Copper, Rust, Bright Olive, Olive, Caraway
 - #4 crewel needle
 - Freezer paper for cutting templates
 - Sharp appliqué scissors
 - 1 yard 902 Burgundy #8 Perle cotton
- 2 yards 300 Brown & 937 Olive #8 Perle cotton
 - 3 yards 738 Gold #8 Perle cotton
